



RYA Advanced Powerboat Instructor Course

Duration - 2 days + 1 evening

Minimum age – 17 years

Pre-requisites – RYA Advance Powerboat Certificate RYA Powerboat level 2 Instructor, RYA First Aid, Day Skipper Theory or knowledge to this level (VHF radio licence, Sea Survival is strongly recommended
Minimum of one full season or 5 seasons part-time powerboat handling experience.
